Entry Check List

Entries must be postmarked by July 5, 2024

Each entry must contain the following items:

- Completed entry form including height of equines
- Signed waiver by driver and all passengers/grooms. Please make note if your groom can't sign until Friday before event.
- Copy of ADS membership card
- Announcer Information Form
- Golf Cart Rental included on entry form (if a golf cart is rented)
- Checks made out to: **Wade House Historic Site** for all fees
- If you are not a member of the ADS, there is a \$30 fee. The fee is \$5 for ADS members. Please include this in your registration. (see Registration form).
- Separate \$50 Stall Deposit. Made out to **Wade House Historic Site**. Check will be destroyed upon stall inspection.
- Negative Coggins test within the previous 12 months, and proper vaccination records. See ADS Rule Book for instructions on vaccination requirements.

Competition Details

ADS Rules

The Wade House Carriage Driving Days is recognized by the American Driving Society, Inc. and will follow all the rules of the society unless otherwise stated in this prize list as a **House** rule. You may download a copy of the Rulebook at www.americandrivingsociety.org. The organizers encourage every competitor to be familiar with all the General regulations and the rules for a Pleasure Driving competition, as the Rulebook is updated every year.

Divisions

Juniors (Youth who have not reached their 19th birthday in 2024, Article: 2.7), VSE (Very Small Equine), Utility Vehicle, Novice Driver, Novice Pony/Horse, Small Pony, Pony, Horse, Pairs/Multiples. There must be at least 4 entries to make a division.

Tires/Wheels

Pneumatic tires permitted only in Utility division classes. The use of wire wheels is permitted for VSE equines only in any class they may enter.

Divisional Classes

Turnout (Article 217), Working (Article 218), Reinsmanship (Article 222), Town & Country Obstacles (Article 248.2), Timed Cones (Article 247), Fault and Out Cones (Article 249.1)

Non-Divisions

Carriage Dog (Article 231), Drive & Ride (Article 227 Walk/Trot), Ladies' Driving Class (Article 219), Gentlemen's Driving Class (Article 220), Concours D'Elegance (Article 230).

Concours D'Elegance: Entry for this class is by invitation of the Judge. The judge will evaluate all turnouts examined on Saturday and invite selected turnouts to the ring for a class shown both directions of the ring at several gaits. The judge will then choose the one entry he or she feels is the BEST at the show. Winner is completely determined by the judge's opinion.

Entries

An entry is defined as a combination of horse(s), vehicle and driver and must be assigned a specific entry number. Organizers of recognized events may limit entries, refuse any entry, cancel, combine or divide a class, alter the proposed time schedule or substitute officials if necessary. (Article: 1.7)

Ribbons and Trophies

Ribbons for 1st – 3rd place ribbons per class. Championship and Reserve ribbons per each division.

Championships will be awarded based on the following points system. 1st = 6, 2nd = 4, 3rd = 3. Ties will be broken based on ADS Rules (Article: 216.3) Championships will be awarded based on the 6 division classes.

House Rules

Antique Vehicle: Can be a restored or an original vehicle made before 1950. Class will be judged as a Turnout class.

Antique Driver or Antique Horse: Either the horse has to be 18 years or older or the driver has to be 65 years or older. Special consideration by the judges for any turnout that meets BOTH requirements. Judged on 50% Working and 50% on Reinsmanship.

General Show Schedule

Stable Opens: Thursday 4:00 pm; **Stable Closes:** Sunday, 6:00pm; **Secretary's Office Opens:** Friday 10:00 am, **Briefings:** Driver's meetings, Thursday, 6:00 pm and Friday, 5:00 pm at the old carriage museum near the old visitors center. Judges and TD will be present for competitors to ask any questions. Drivers must attend one of the meetings. **Arena Dedication Celebration:** Saturday; 5:30 pm at the Arena. Heavy hors d'oeuvres and beverages. **Awards Party:** Sunday, one hour after last class.

Fees

Entries: Entries open April 15 and close July 5. Entries postmarked by July 5 will be accepted. **Entry/Class Fees:** \$16/class; Juniors \$12/class, **Pleasure Combined Test:** \$50/entry; **Post Entry Fees:** \$18/class, Pleasure Combined Test: \$60 with Organizer approval; **Entry Fee Refund Policy:** Full refund less \$25 before closing date. Full refund only with Vet or Doctor's certificate less \$50 after the closing date. **Golf Cart:** \$190 for a single seat. Rental fees can be in your entry/stall check. **Stall Fee:** \$150 per horse. Limited shavings available \$8/bag – order on registration form.

Stall Refund Policy: Stalls are non-refundable after the closing date. **Other Fees:** Working out of trailer/camping: \$75 per turnout for show.

I hereby expressly agree without any limitation or condition for myself and my principals, representative, employees and agents: (1) to be bound by the rules and by-laws of the ADS and any local rules of this Competition; (2) that every horse, driver, attendant, groom and/or passenger is eligible as entered; and (3) to accept as final any decision of the Competition officials on any question arising under the ADS rules and by-laws or any local rules of the Competition.
